 - Remember that the design should incorporate
 - Text, layout spacing, background objects, mid-ground objects and foreground focus
 - Colours that are reflective of the themes from the series and the main character
 - Ideas to attract the targeted audience (make sure it is appealing to 11-14 year) olds)
 - Skills in the use of technologies (you can use a software illustrator program or develop the design by hand)
 - Detail, which is important to overall finish and presentation of the design
- Design a poster to advertise the Lockie Leonard TV series
 - Remember that the design should incorporate
 - A layout that presents immediate information about the series to the audience
 - A balance between text (size, shape and font) and image
 - Colours and shapes that are reflective of the themes from the series and the main character
 - Ideas to attract the targeted audience (make sure it is appealing to 11-14 year olds)
 - Skills in the use of technologies (you can use a software illustrator program or develop the design by hand)
 - Detail, which is important to overall finish and presentation of the design
- Design a life-size cardboard cut-out of Lockie to stand in the library, directing students to the Lockie Leonard books.
 - Remember that the design should incorporate
 - A realistic or cartoon interpretation of what Lockie would look like
 - 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional components, for example, clothes to dress up the cut-out, a wig, sunglasses, etc.
 - A mechanism that allows it to stand by itself, therefore free standing or attached to a wall or shelving.
 - Sound: think about what a directional character would say and how it would . sound.
